
You do NOT need to sign the copy that you received in the mail. This is for your reference only.

If you are on a month-to-month lease, I will have you sign a new lease agreement in May.

If you are on an annual lease, I will have you sign a new lease agreement when your lease comes due.

I will mail a notice to you when it's time for you to come in and sign.
