Playground

Playground Rules

Hours: **8:00 am to dusk**

1. Use playground at your own risk; adult supervision recommended.
2. Be considerate of others; no rough playing, yelling or foul language.
3. Be respectful and use equipment properly. Do not use when wet.
4. No food or glass in play area.
5. Wear proper footwear. No bare feet.
6. Take turns and play nice.
7. Place balls in benches and clean up before you leave.
8. Keep basketball surface clean. No bikes allowed on the court.
9. Hoop height adjustment by management only.
10. No hanging the hoop structure or brackets.

Speed limit in Pinewood Court is **15 mph** at all times.

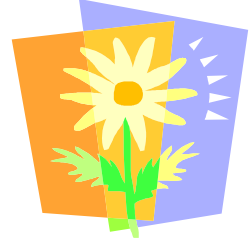
Walkers, bikers and cars all share the same roadway. We need to keep everyone safe.
